Educational Approach

GAA offers an enriched U.S. collegepreparatory curriculum leading to a U.S. High School Diploma, a US High School Diploma with IB certificates or the full International Baccalaureate curriculum leading to the IB Diploma. English is the language of instruction, and most students study two additional languages as Arabic is required by the Ministry of Education. Rigorous academic offerings, including IB Diploma courses, are complemented by a broad array of electives in the arts, sciences and history. Community service, as well as extra-curricular sports teams and clubs round out the program, cultivating leadership skills and social engagement. One full credit is earned by completing two semesters of a course that meets approximately 200 minutes a week.



Grading, Ranking, G.P.A Distribution and Senior Class Size

Letter grades are given for all courses. Grades earned at other schools are not included in the calculation of the GAA GPA. Transcripts and report cards from other schools are attached to the GAA transcript.

Students are not ranked because of small classes and the dissimilarity of the various programs and grading systems from previous schools attended.

All IB students receive a 0.25 weight per class for SL and 0.50 per class for HL for each IB class taken.


