**DEPOSIT:** <u>A Non-Refundable</u>, 4000 AED is required. If trips are not approved by ADEC or are cancelled do to lack of interest, refunds will be made. If you are relocated before the trip takes place, refunds will be made.

**REGISTRATION FORM**: After deposit payment has been made to Accounts, your registration form should be returned to the Athletic Office not later than the <u>November 2nd</u>.

*Please note:* No registration form will be accepted unless it is complete and no seat will be reserved until the first deposit has been received by the due date.

# **General Information**

## SAFETY AND SECURITY

The GAA Spring Break Trips program exposes students to a degree of risk that is atypical of regular on-campus classes. While the trips involving travel, physical activity and exploration are not risk free, safety is of paramount importance and is emphasized as courses are planned and take place.

Teacher-Advisors are briefed about what to do in an emergency and have the authority to make decisions, change the itinerary, or do whatever else is necessary to ensure the safety of the students.

You can be assured that the school takes the safety of the students and advisors seriously. If conditions warrant, a trip may be changed or cancelled due to concerns about safety, political instability, or security. In these situations, GAA will be made refunds.

## MEDICAL

Parents are required to complete a health form and students must submit it at the time of trip registration. The school and advisors need to be aware of any medical issues, physical conditions or allergies along with any medications students will be taking during the trip. For more information about recommended shots <u>or</u> boosters for a specific country, the school will provide as much information as possible; however it is each parent's responsibility to consult with your physician at least 6 weeks prior to the student's departure.

The course sponsors will carry a first aid kit that will contain typical items that might be needed. Sponsors have access to an emergency phone number where they can get medical advice while outside of the country. Emergency medical evacuation and insurance coverage is **NOT** included in the fee and must be purchased independently.

## PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS

Students must have a passport with at least **6 months of validity remaining** (six months after the student's departure date for their GAA Spring Break trip).

Depending on the student's passport and the trip selected,

visa may be required. The cost of the visa is **NOT** included in the trip fees and the price for said visas may vary. The school will provide as much information as possible for obtaining the necessary visas and assistance as as possible; however obtaining such visas is the responsibility of the parent.

# All Non-Emirati Nationals must ensure they have a valid exit/re-entry visa BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS

Positive interaction among students, faculty, guides and local people is a hallmark of all GAA Spring break trips. It is unacceptable for students to inconvenience others, or jeopardize the safety of the group. Students must satisfy the sponsors that they have the background to enjoy the course and that they will be supportive of the group for the duration of the course. Students are expected to study the trip schedule and ensure they have the physical ability to participate in **ALL** activities.

All the GAA school rules are in effect for the duration of the course. The regular prohibitions regarding insubordination, tobacco, illegal non=prescription drugs and alcohol will be in effect at all times. Flagrant curfew violations or going to "off limits" areas will not be tolerated and all laws of the local country must be obeyed. Advisors in consultation with the administration, have full authority to send home a student whose conduct is unacceptable or compromises the safety of the group. If it necessary to send a student home, it will be at the parent's expense.

## **STUDENTS RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Students Must become familiar with their trip/event itinerary.
- Students Must obtain parents approval for any trip/event they participate in.
- Students Must meet all the requirements outlined in the trip/event guide.
- Students Must attend all orientations and meetings
- Students Must complete all registration requirements
- Students Must ensure that parents have ALL the information given.
- Students Must agree to all pre and post-course work associated with the trip/event.
- Students Must adhere to all behavior expectations as identified.
- Students Must cooperate equally with all members of their group.

## PARENT RESPONSIBILITY

- Parents Should attend the information sessions.
- Parents Should assist their sons/daughters in making the trip decision that best supports their strengths.





- Parents Should ensure that their child continues to stay focused on their studies and behavioral responsibilities.
- Parents Should support the teachers/organisers by encouraging their child to value and make the most of their trip/event.
- Parent Should support the eligibility requirements as outlined below.
- Parents Should ensure that all forms and funding are processed prior or on due dates we are unable to allow any exceptions.
- Parents Must have paid in full all financial obligations as outlined.

## ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Any student who has had an out-of-school suspension during any part of the academic year may be ineligible to attend the GAA Spring Break trips.
- 2. Any student under academic concern may be subject to pre-evaluation before they receive permission to attend GAA Spring Break trip.
- 3. Any student under behavioral concern will be subject to pre-evaluation before they receive permission to attend the GAA Spring Break trip.

## **REQUIRED DOCUMENT/OBLIGATIONS**

- 1. All forms completed/signed are required to register.
  - Registration Form
  - Waiver Form
  - Physical Approval Form
  - Emergency Treatment Form
  - Swim Permission Form if applicable
  - Travel Acceptance and Permission Form
- 2. A Non-refundable and Non-Transferable processing deposit fee of AED 4000
- 3. A colored photocopy of passport and a colored photocopy of student's Emirates ID front and back.

4. Processing of trip visas well in advance of departure (if applicable). Each student is responsible for acquiring the necessary visas on their own accord and to submit a colored photocopy of the visa to the Director of Athletics and Activities office.

## Visa Requirements

**Passport/Visa requirements:** In order to visit Indonesia, a visa is required for most nationalities. **Visa On Arrival** can be obtained directly when you are landed at the certain airports and seaport in Indonesia regardless of the purpose of your visits (Business, Tourist, Social). We are strongly advised to obtain a tourist visa made at Indonesian Embassy in Abu Dhabi. The maximum stays permitted for the tourist visa is 30 days. **All the South East Asia nationals (Brunei Darussalam, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam) are NOT require tourist visas for a stay up to 21 and 30 days respectively.** 

These are the documents necessary for obtaining tourist visa:

- Expiration date of the applicant's passport must be at least 6 (six) months at the date of entry.
- At least two blank visa pages
- Round-trip airplane ticket

The fees for tourist visa are:

- Visa for stay up to 7 (seven) days = US\$ 15,-
- Visa for stay up to 30 (thirty) days = US\$ 35,-

- The primary treatment in the form of an airtight septic tank and piping. The septic tank kills some harmful bacteria and produces nutrients.

## **Visa Requirements**

Visas are available on arrival at the international airport in Kathmandu and at all land border crossings that are open to foreigners, as long as you have passport photos to hand and can pay the visa fee in foreign currency (some crossings insist on payment in US dollars). Your passport must be valid for at least six months and you will need a whole free page for your visa.

The *following passport holders* need to apply for a VISA from the Nepal Embassy prior to travelling to Nepal. Nigeria, Ghana, Zimbabwe, Swaziland, Cameroon, Somalia, Liberia, Ethiopia, Iraq, Palestine, Afghanistan, Syria, Refugees with travel document.

## Itinerary

### Day 1 Arrive (Dinner and overnight at hotel)

Arrive at Kathmandu airport and drive to the hotel. After check-in, there will be a safety and orientation briefing on your expedition followed by dinner and rest and relaxation at the hotel.

## Day 2 Rock climbing / sightseeing at Monkey Temple

(Dinner and overnight at hotel in Kathmandu)

After breakfast we will transfer to the rock-climbing site. Students will be divided into smaller groups for teaching and safety purposes. Around midday we will break for a picnic lunch before learning more rock climbing techniques, belay, lead climbing and much more. Students will learn the value of teamwork, and will develop key team skills whilst enjoying the physical challenge of climbing. After finishing the climbing if we have time we can visit Monkey Temple.

## Day 3 Mountain biking expedition (Dinner and overnight at hotel in Kathmandu)

This morning, depending on the group and their cycling capabilities, we will start either directly from the hotel or drive to a cycling start point. Today students will enjoy a 6-7 hour cycle ride, close to Kathmandu valley. Students will be taught about the importance of planning and preparation of expeditions and also learn about the technical side of mountain biking. Again, the group will enjoy a picnic lunch in the beautiful surroundings of Kathmandu valley.

# Day 4 White water rafting / beach camping (Dinner and overnight at beach camp)

This morning after breakfast we will journey for around 3 hours to arrive at the rafting location. After a half hour briefing on safety and key points, we will begin rafting. Our start point may vary, dependent on the weather and current of the river on that particular day. Initially, wherever we start, we will begin with small rapids and soon will catch up with bigger ones! After arriving at the camp, tent allocation and free till dinner.

## Day 7 Hike to Khopasi / drive to Kathmandu (Dinner and overnight at hotel in Kathmandu)

After a final campsite breakfast, the group will hike to Khopasi, before returning by bus to Kathmandu. After checking in to the hotel, the group will enjoy some well deserved rest and relaxation and dinner.

Depending on flight times, the group will have some free time before transferring to the airport for your departure flight.



- Applications for long-term visas (over 90 days, National Visa) must be filed directly with the responsible Swiss representation abroad.

In addition, certain Swiss representations abroad offer the possibility to make an online appointment for the submission of the visa application. *VFS Global* has been chosen as the service provider for managing the visa application submission in the UAE. Visa applications must be submitted at the Swiss Visa Application Centres in Dubai or Abu Dhabi. All applications will be assessed by the Embassy of Switzerland in Abu Dhabi.





## 8 day Borneo Discovery Itinerary

## Day 1: Arrive Kota Kinabalu and transfer to

**community camp (Overnight Community Camp)** Arrive in the state capital of Kota Kinabalu and transfer (3 hours) to one of our community camps. On arrival at the camp you will be welcomed by staff with refreshments. After settling into the traditional style accommodation, the team will receive a full safety and orientation brief which will include a walking tour of the community and project sites. After dinner, local school children will perform a traditional welcome dance.

### Day 2: Cultural brief / community project (Overnight Community Camp)

After breakfast, the morning is filled with sessions on traditional ways of life such as introduction to local cooking and handicrafts as well as a chance to meet people from the local community and see how they live. In the afternoon, the team will be given a thorough briefing on the community project and time permitting they will make a start on their project work.

### Day 3 - 4: Community project (Overnight Community Camp)

After a hearty breakfast, the team will continue with their project work before learning about permaculture techniques and how they are put into place in camp. Group activities will follow after dinner in camp.

### Day 5: Sepilok Orangutan Sanctuary (Overnight Hotel)

Take a short flight over to Sandakan where the team's hard work on previous days is rewarded with a visit to the world-renowned Sepilok Orangutan Sanctuary. Here they take in and care for orphaned orangutans and rehabilitate them back into the wild. No visit to Borneo would be complete without seeing these incredible animals. Take the short walk next door to get to the SunBear Conservation Centre - a rescue and rehabilitation centre for the endangered Bornean Sun Bear. The team will then get the chance to explore the historic town of Sandakan before returning to the hotel to freshen up before a well-deserved group dinner.

### Day 6: Drive to Kota Kinabalu / river cruise on Kilias River (Overnight Fireflies eco-camp)

Drive back to Kota Kinabalu and transfer onto an ecocamp on the bank of the Kilias river on the west coast of Sabah. Upon arrival the group will have lunch and settle into their accommodation before heading out on a wildlife river cruise where they will see all sorts of wildlife including the striking Proboscis monkey. In the afternoon, there will be activities and traditional games and after dinner, the group will witness the amazing fireflies display on a night-time cruise.

### Day 7: Utan Paradise Jungle Camp (Overnight Utan Paradise Base Camp)

After an early start and early morning cruise on the river to see the early morning wildlife, the team will transfer to Utan Paradise Jungle Camp. On arrival the team will have lunch and settle into the dorm accommodation. In the afternoon the team will learn traditional jungle skills that the local people have used for hundreds of years including making traditional traps and will enjoy a short trek through the jungle. The team will also assist with the Utan Paradise reforestation project working on either expanding the nursery, collecting seeds and planting them or planting out saplings that are ready. This work helps to ensure that important tree species are replaced providing food sources for local wildlife as well as replacing hardwood trees. After dinner, there will be an insect observation session where the team will get to see the insects that make all that noise in the jungle by shining a light on a white sheet.

### Day 8: Depart

After breakfast, the group will transfer to Kota Kinabalu International Airport for their departure flight.

Although it is our intention to operate the itinerary as detailed above, it may be necessary to make some changes as a result of climatic conditions, alterations to flight schedules, or other operational factors.
